Good morning, UNAN! Today is Friday, May 10th, 2019.

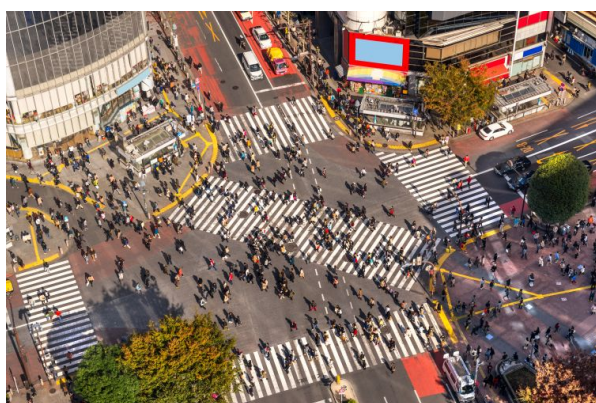

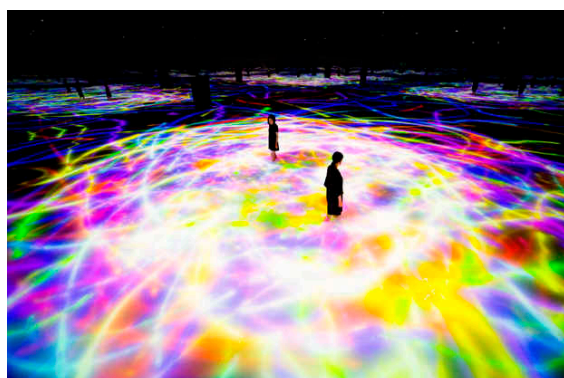
